Assignment: As we continue our study of numbers, weather, cultural awareness, and public speaking in German 1, you are to create, with one (1) partner, a two (2) to five (5) minute weather forecast broadcast of a German speaking city (listed below) in German. You must include a 72 Hour forecast, ten (10) day forecast, graphic which can include satellite and/or radar images, high and low temperatures, percentage of chance of precipitation, the weather itself (cloudy, partly cloudy, snow showers, etc.) and at least one extra (i.e. Golf Guide, Beach Watch, Hiking Forecast, etc. - which must be regionally specific to your chosen city/area). Presentation can be live (using a PowerPoint® presentation or program of the like), or may be pre-recorded and shown to the class. During the presentation, one should dress as if they were a TV broadcaster and being broadcasted to the entire city or area (gentlemen should wear ties; ladies should wear a blouse, etc. - No T-shirts, Jeans, Tennis Shoes). Your forecasted period (10 days) may be real-live (today through the next five days), or can be based on the historical average during another season (please specify).
